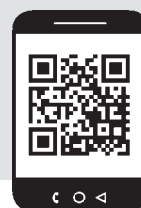

To be effective, all votes must be lodged by 09.30 a.m. (Irish time) on Tuesday, 27 January 2026 either (1) via the website www.eproxyappointment.com; (2) at the office of the Company's Registrar at Computershare Investor Services (Ireland) Limited, P.O. Box 13030, 3100 Lake Drive, Citywest Business Campus, Dublin 24, D24 AK82, Ireland; or (3) at the registered office of the Company.

Explanatory Notes:

- Any shareholder entitled to attend, speak and vote at the AGM is entitled to appoint one or more proxies (who need not be a member of the Company) to attend, speak and vote in his/her place. If you wish to appoint a person other than the Chair of the AGM, please insert the name and address of your chosen proxy holder in the space provided (see reverse). A shareholder may appoint more than one proxy to attend and vote at the meeting provided each proxy is appointed to exercise rights attached to different shares held by him or her. If the proxy is being appointed in relation to less than your full voting entitlement, please enter in the box next to the proxy holder's name (see reverse) the number of shares in relation to which they are authorised to act as your proxy. If left blank your proxy will be deemed to be authorised in respect of your full voting entitlement (or if this proxy form has been issued in respect of a designated account for a member, the full voting entitlement for that designated account). Where a poll is taken at the AGM, a member, present in person or proxy, holding more than one share is not required to cast all their votes in the same way. Persons appointed as a proxy or corporate representative for a shareholder, including CDI Holders or EB Participants (as defined in the Notice of AGM) who have appointed themselves as proxy as set out in Notes 6 and 7 of the Notice of AGM, should make themselves known to the personnel at the registration desk in order to gain entry to the meeting.

Please indicate in the box next to the proxy holder's name (see reverse) the number of shares in relation to which they are authorised to act as your proxy. - To be effective, the completed Form of Proxy together with any power of attorney or other authority under which it is executed, or a notarially certified copy thereof, must be deposited with the Company's Registrar before the deadline set out above. - The 'Vote Withheld' option overleaf is provided to enable you to abstain on any particular resolution. However, it should be noted that a 'Vote Withheld' is not a vote in law and will not be counted in the calculation of the proportion of the votes 'For' and 'Against' a resolution.
- Pursuant to Section 1087G of the Companies Act 2014 (as amended), entitlement to attend and vote at the AGM and the number of votes which may be cast thereat will be determined by reference to the Register of Members of the Company as at the close of business (deemed to be 6.00 p.m. (Irish time)) on Sunday, 25 January 2026 (or in the case of an adjournment as at the close of business on the day which is four days before the date of the adjourned meeting). Changes to entries on the Register of Members after that time shall be disregarded in determining the rights of any person to attend and vote at the AGM.
- All proxy voting instructions whether submitted directly by way of a completed Form of Proxy in the case of holders of Ordinary Shares book-entry form or through the Euroclear System (in the case of EB Participants) or CREST (in the case of CDI Holders) must be received by the Company's Registrar by no later than 09.30 a.m. (Irish time) on Tuesday, 27 January 2026 (or, in the case of an adjournment, no later than 48 hours before the time fixed for holding the adjourned meeting). Persons holding interests in Ordinary Shares through the Euroclear System or CREST (via a holding in CDIs) will also need to comply with any additional voting deadlines imposed by the respective service offerings. All persons affected are recommended to consult with their stockbroker or other intermediary at the earliest opportunity.
