About the awards

Welcome to the new Greencore Annual Shine Awards. These are our Group-wide recognition awards – they will put a spotlight on colleagues who have shown real drive and dedication to helping improve our business.

The awards complement our existing local Greencore Way Awards but also give us the opportunity to share examples of best practice, ideas, and initiatives that colleagues have been involved in right across our business.

Our first ever annual Shine Awards also give us an opportunity to recognise the determination, skill, commitment, and bravery colleagues have displayed over the past 18 months.

The awards cover 13 categories and there are a mix of individual and team awards to choose from. We are looking for nominations that cover work which has taken place between January 2020 and August 2021. You can nominate anyone – someone you work with, your team, a different team, your supervisor or manager, or even yourself!

You can submit as many nominations as you like - but remember to check whether your chosen category is for an individual or team nomination. If you would like to nominate in more than one category, you will need to use a separate form for each nomination.

The closing date for entries is Friday 10
September so don't delay, look at the
categories, complete an entry form and
nominate your colleagues today!



Submitting your entry

Once you have decided who you wish to nominate, what award you think they deserve and why, simply fill in the application form in this booklet and use the details on the back page to submit it to our Communications team.

You can download an electronic version of the form from our intranet or complete your nomination directly through our My Core Benefits platform.

Please note there will be a two-stage process to nominations. If your entry is shortlisted, you will be asked to provide more evidence and details of why you think your chosen colleague(s) is/are deserving winners. At this second stage, you will have to provide more detailed examples of the benefits that have been achieved by the individual or team.

We've given a maximum word count for the application – please stick to this as any additional words may not be taken into account when shortlisting applications.

How will the awards be judged?

Each category will have a panel of judges for both the first and second stages of nomination. The panels consist of subject matter experts, members of our awards steering team and all our Group Leadership Team.

The nominators and nominees of all entries that are shortlisted for second stage judging will be invited to an awards ceremony which will take place on Wednesday 8 December 2021.



The Categories

Title	What we are looking for
Inspiring leader (Individual award)	This award is for a leader who has shown exceptional leadership qualities. We are looking for someone who engages people, inspires a team and consistently demonstrates care and trust. This will be a person who has earned the respect of colleagues by listening to their ideas and opinions, supporting their growth and keeping them informed about things that matter to them.
Early careers talent (Individual award)	This award recognises colleagues who are studying on one of the following early careers programmes: Degree Apprentices, Technical Graduate Programme, Finance Graduate Programme, or our Engineering Apprenticeship Scheme. We are looking for an individual who has displayed a proactive and positive attitude to all tasks given to them. We want to recognise someone who inspires others in their approach to their development and their desire to always learn more.
Growing with Greencore (Individual award)	In this category, we are looking for a colleague at any level of the business who you have seen demonstrate commitment to their own growth and development at Greencore. They might be an apprentice or someone developing their career by using our Line Manager or Line Coordinator Framework, or doing something else that has brought benefits to their role and/or to other people. We want to shine a spotlight on colleagues who continuously strive to enhance their own development.
Colleague support (Individual award)	This award recognises colleagues who have gone the extra mile to support others during the difficult times we have all faced through the coronavirus pandemic. We are looking for individuals who have been dedicated to the wellbeing of others. Examples include colleagues who have taken time out of their normal roles to support, encourage and look after others.
Colleague of the year (Individual award)	This is a very open category where we ask the question "Who has inspired you?" We are looking for individuals who stand out for what they have done to support the business in the last 18 months. We are looking for colleagues who have taken it upon themselves to do something extraordinary in the workplace. Who are the unsung heroes that we should be shining a light on?
Customer partnering (Team award)	This award will recognise examples of successful external customer partnerships that demonstrate how we work collaboratively. Is there a customer relationship that you're proud of? Have we grown market share by working together? Is there a project your team has worked on in conjunction with a customer that has been beneficial to them and Greencore?

Title	What we are looking for
Product launch (Team award)	This award will recognise a team that has delivered product innovation since January 2020. We are looking for examples of new product (or product re-development) projects that demonstrate a high level of internal, cross-functional collaboration and have delivered on the original objectives.
Supplier partnering (Team award)	In this category, we are looking for a team that can demonstrate the value we have gained from working in partnership with a supplier or group of suppliers. We will be looking for examples of how risks have been managed and how outcomes have resulted in positive benefits for both parties.
Community engagement (Team award)	This award will go to a group of colleagues who have shown outstanding support to their local community. Their devotion and commitment to helping others will have inspired other colleagues to also get involved in community activity. This award covers site initiatives or activities that smaller groups have undertaken – what we are looking for are examples of colleagues who take pleasure in supporting the local community through volunteering, community work and/or fundraising.
Delivering excellence (Team or individual award)	This award will shine a light on teams who have driven ideas and initiatives to support our efficiency, built capability, and/or created value in the business. The focus is not just on any monetary value of what has been achieved but also on how it was achieved and other benefits.
Driving sustainability (Team award)	In this category, we are looking for ideas and initiatives that have been implemented locally or across several of our sites to support our sustainability work. We will be looking for evidence where we have sourced with integrity, made our products with care and/or fed Britain with pride.
Keeping our people safe (Team award)	This award recognises locally instigated activity which drives and embeds a safety culture at Greencore. We are looking for teams that have shown outstanding commitment to improving our working culture by implementing projects, activities, or behaviours that have helped to keep our people safe.
Food heroes (Team award)	This award is focused on our colleagues who have participated in, and held together the front-line of our business over the course of the pandemic, with specific focus on our manufacturing and distribution teams. We are looking for teams that have made a big impact to our business over the last 18 months.
